#### Supplementary Guidance – Burglary

To qualify as a MAPPA Category 2 offender, you must have a conviction for **Section 9, 1(a)** only and also the element must be with the intent to inflict GBH or to commit unlawful damage therein.

If the conviction under Section 9, 1a) is the theft element, then they do not qualify.
